COVID-19 DIGITAL CERTIFICATE

You can now add your COVID-19 digital certificate to the Service Victoria app through myGov or the Express Medicare Plus App. Make sure that your Medicare online account is linked to your myGov account.

If you don't have access to a smartphone, you can ask your GP, pharmacy, or community centre where you received your vaccination to print it for you or call Services Australia on 1800 653 809.

If you need help linking your Covid-19 certificate to your Services Victoria app, please don't hesitate to get in touch by calling my office and one of my friendly staff can assist.

In October, I was pleased to announce that 95 new car parking spaces will be coming to Sydenham Road as part of the Andrews Labor Government's Car Parks for Commuters program, which will be delivered by Brimbank City Council.

Stage one of upgrades at Sydenham Road will include more car parks, safety upgrades, a shared user path and tree planting. Whether you walk, ride, or drive to the station, the upgrade will allow for a safer and easier commute to and from work.

\$307 MILLION DOLLAR BOOST FOR OUR HEALTHCARE SYSTEM

Boosting their capacity to transport suspected COVID-19 patients

The Victorian Government is investing \$307 million for Victoria's health system to hold the line against COVID-19, making the most of our resources within hospitals and increase in home and community care options to keep our critical care beds ready for those who need them most.

The funding includes:

- \$87 million to increase hospital at home to free up more than 100 public hospital beds in metropolitan Melbourne
- \$42 million for the COVID Positive Pathways program to employ more staff to support COVID positive patients to remain at home during their recovery, and additional staff to navigate COVID care from hospital back into their home.
- More than \$40 million for Ambulance Victoria to boost their capacity to manage increased COVID caseload and provide surge capacity for patients with less serious conditions that still require hospitalisation

Additionally, the State Government is increasing additional workforce funding, funding for Aboriginal health organisations to provide more care and to support patients with disability.

LAND SECURED FOR A NEW AMBULANCE STATION IN TAYLORS LAKES

The Andrews Labor Government is boosting ambulance resources in Taylors Lakes, making sure paramedics have the facilities and support they need to quickly respond to local emergencies and save lives.

The new 24-hour ambulance branch on Kings Road, in Taylors Lakes will feature a four-bay garage, four bedrooms for our hard-working paramedics to rest and recuperate, training facilities, a fully equipped kitchen and improved security and car parking to make sure our paramedics are safe.

The new Taylors Lakes ambulance branch is being delivered in partnership with the May Constructions and is expected to be completed in mid-2022.

AIR PURIFIERS ON THEIR WAY TO LOCAL SCHOOLS

51,000 air purifiers are being rolled out to all government and low-fee non-government schools during Term 4 to remove potentially infectious particles from higher-risk areas in schools.

The first schools to receive air purifiers across Sydenham included **Copperfield College**, Taylors Lakes Secondary College, Springside West Secondary College, Catholic Regional College, Catholic Regional College Keilor North and Gilson College. Additionally, schools were eligible to apply for grants of up to \$25,000 to purchase shade sails – with \$60 million to create more outdoor learning spaces and make it easy for classes to be conducted outside. We've also rolled out free, at-home rapid antigen tests for unvaccinated students.

These are just some of the measures the Andrews Labor Government is taking to make sure our classes are as safe as possible, and our school communities are protected.
